## Dr. Vijayalakshmi Kamat Award Session (For challenging video presentation)

#### **Guidelines**

#### What is the nature of the contest?

 It is a video based award session, where the imaging modality has been instrumental in changing the outcome of a clinical scenario or a series of clinical cases.

#### Who can participate?

- The Challenging video should be presented by a member of the association (IACTA).
- The presenter should be less than 45 years of age.
- The presenter should be a registered delegate for the Chennai Cardiac Anesthesia Update 2025.

#### What is the prize?

- The award is given to the best video presentation, judged by a committee set up by the organizers.
- The award is a cheque / cash award of Rs. 15,000/-

#### What is the judging process?

- A Maximum of 6 presentations will be allowed.
- Each presentation will be for 10 minutes (7 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for discussion).
- A panel of 2 eminent judges, chosen by the organizing committee will evaluate the presentations. The decision of the judges will be final & binding, and cannot be contested.

- Any request to know the individual marks will not be entertained.
- The evaluation of the powerpoint presentation will be based on the following criteria:
- i. Quality & relevant content of images
- ii. Quality & style of presentation
- iii. Quality of discussion / reply to questions
- iv. Scientific content

#### Should I send an abstract?

- The abstract should be sent to iactachennai@gmail.com on or before 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2025 in word format.
- Please limit abstract to 250 words or less.
- There shall be one presenting author who would be the main author or the corresponding author.
- If there are more than 6 entries, the best 6 abstracts will be chosen for the podium presentation.

#### Format of presentation:

Final presentation will be in powerpoint format

#### **GUIDELINES FOR FREE PAPER PRESENTATION**

#### What is the nature of the contest?

Free paper presentation includes research work (clinical / basic science) related to cardiac anesthesia or case studies.

#### 1. Case studies:

Description of interesting events and practices that occur in cardiac anesthesia, critical care or pain medicine, with some educational value. It should contain a description of case with findings, discussion and a learning point.

#### 2. Research work:

A systematic investigation designed to develop or contribute to knowledge enhancement in cardiac anesthesia. The research work must be original and should contain the following sections: Objectives, methods, results, discussion and conclusion.

#### Who can participate?

- 1. Should be a member of IACTA and should be less than 45 years of age.
- 2. The presenter should be a registered delegate for Chennai Cardiac Anesthesia Update 2025.

#### What is the prize?

• A cash prize / cheque of Rs.20,000/- for the winner, as decided by the committee set up by the organizers.

#### What is the judging process?

- A maximum of 10 presentations will be allowed
- Each presentation will be 6 minutes (4 minutes for the presentation and 2 minutes for Q&A)
- A panel of 3 eminent judges will evaluate the presentations. Their decision will be final and binding.
- The final presentation shall be in the 'power-point' format.
- The evaluation will be based on the following criteria:
  - a) Content: Relevance and appropriateness.
  - b) Originality
  - c) Clarity in delivery
  - d) Time management
  - e) Response to questions.

#### Should I send an abstract?

- An abstract in the 'WORD' format should be sent to iactachennai@gmail.com on or before 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2025 - 5.00 pm
- The abstract should be limited to 250 words.
